

Nettleton Parish Council
Minutes of meeting held at West Kington Baptist Chapel

Declarations of interest: Cllr. Pearce declared an interest in planning item 1. The Old Granary, Nettleton.

The minutes of a meeting held on 28th June 2012, which had been previously circulated to Councillors, were unanimously approved with two amendments.

1. Public Participation: none

2. Planning:

- a. N/12/01591/LBC The Old Granary, Nettleton. After much discussion, including in put from neighbours it was agreed that this required a site visit. To be arranged in the next week.
- b. N12/01528/S106 Burton Farm, no objection by unanimous vote.
- c. N/12/01419/LBC Priory Court, Nettleton. 'Nettleton Parish Council feel this is a technical issue outside the scope of councillors knowledge and ask that this be carefully considered by the conservation officer' by unanimous vote.
- d. N/12/01519/FULL 1 The Meads, Burton. No objections by unanimous vote.

3. Bench:

It was reported that the bench in Nettleton had been removed by its owner, the Clerk was asked to find out if Wilts Council would provide a replacement. It was also reported that the replacement bench in West Kington had never been installed.

4. Noticeboard in Burton:

It was reported that the noticeboard in Burton had been replaced by the owner of the building on which it is hung.

5. Drainage:

It was reported that work is still under way although Wiltshire Council's progress is slow.

It was reported that the problem in Church Lane is now very bad, Clerk to pursue with highways.

6. Foot paths:

It was reported that the footpath between the land of the Pryors and the Wilks is very over grown, the Clerk to write and remind owners to cut their hedges back.
