

Nettleton Parish Council

Minutes of meeting held at West Kington Baptist Chapel

On 13th September 2012 at 7.30pm.

Parish Councillors present: Mr P Broadhurst (Chair), Mrs A Flint, Mr J Wright, Mr D Kerr, Mrs D Bell and Mrs M Riddell.

Apologies: Mrs Trubody, Mrs Pearce and Mrs Bush

Also Present: 1 member of the public and Cllr. Scott

Declarations of interest: Cllr. Wright declared an interest in 2 Fosse Cottage, Nettleton.

The minutes of a meeting held on 12th July 2012, which had been previously circulated to Councillors, were unanimously approved.

Matters Arising from the previous meeting:

1. Details of the teak bench had been circulated but several cllrs favour a plastic option, pricing to be collected. **Clerk**
2. It was agreed that the footpath between the Wilks and the Priors land had an overgrown hedge which was impeding people using it. It was agreed that the Priors should be contacted and a notice put in the Honeycomb reminding people of their responsibilities. **Clerk**
3. Cllr. Riddell queried whether noticeboards in Nettleton needed replacing. **MR to investigate.**
4. **Public Participation:** Mr De Wec spoke on the subject of large agricultural machinery taking in appropriate routes through the villages and damaging walls, trees and verges. It was agreed that the Clerk should write to Church Farm pointing this out. **Clerk**
5. **Planning:**
 - a. N/12/02930/S73A Fosse Cottages, Nettleton. No objections by unanimous vote.
 - b. N/12/02158/LBC The Old Cottage, Nettleton. No objections by unanimous vote.
6. **Finance:**
 - a. Expenses of £29.70 to Cllr. Riddell for a training course attendance.
7. **Highways:**
 - a. Cllr. Broadhurst reported that the verges had not been flailed at some very important junctions.
 - b. Cllr, Broadhurst expressed disappointment that the S. Glos speed limit up to Burton had not meant the knock on effect of a more sensible set of speed limits through Burton.
 - c. Cllr. Riddell requested a Burton road sign at the Marshfield – Tormarton junction.
 - d. Cllr. Riddell reported that the new highways co-ordinator was Richard Dobson.
 - e. The Clerk reported her frustration at the failure of WC to deliver a replacement grit bin to Edgecorner Lane despite repeated requests.

Cllr. Scott to investigate all of the Highways items.

8. **Cllr. Broadhurst** asked for a Cllr. to attend the Community Campus meeting on the 19th September, no Cllrs were available the Clerk agreed to attend in their absence.

9. **St Mary's Burton and Nettleton**, requested a donation towards grass cutting, it was agreed that this should form part of a wider discussion in October.
